'20/20' IS THE NO. 1 FRIDAY NEWSMAGAZINE, LEADING 'DATELINE' BY DOUBLE DIGITS ACROSS THE BOARD: TOTAL VIEWERS, ADULTS 18-49 AND ADULTS 25-54

Season to Date, '20/20' Is Outdelivering 'Dateline' in All Key Demos

For the 2^{nd} week in a row, "20/20" stood as Friday's No. 1 newsmagazine and beat NBC's "Dateline" by double digits in Total Viewers (+33% - 2.8 million vs. 2.1 million), Adults 18-49 (+33% - 0.4/3 vs. 0.3/3) and Adults 25-54 (+40% - 0.7/4 vs. 0.5/3).

Season to date, "20/20" **is leading NBC's "Dateline" in Total Viewers** (+3% - 3.1 million vs. 3.0 million), **Adults 18-49** (+25% - 0.5/4 vs. 0.4/3) **and Adults 25-54** (+17% - 0.7/4 vs. 0.6/3).

"20/20" featured the first TV interview with Vanessa Guillen's fiancé, one year after her murder.
