Gabby Petito hoped her upcoming trip with fiancé Brian Laundrie would be an adventure of a lifetime when they outfitted a van to travel across the country, visiting national parks and monuments and documenting it via social media. After several months into their trip, Gabby disappeared, and her parents reported her missing. Soon after, authorities discovered her body near Grand Teton National Park, and Brian was named a person of interest in her death. “GMA3” co-anchor **Eva Pilgrim** reports on the case in the season two finale of the “20/20” limited true crime series “Bad Romance,” airing **Monday, May 19 (8:00-9:00 p.m. EDT) on ABC** and streaming the next day on [Hulu](https://www.hulu.com).
