Premiering Live for the First Time on Disney+ Friday, Nov. 3

The Induction Ceremony will be broadcast live coast to coast on Disney+ from Brooklyn, New York, on FRIDAY, NOV. 3 (8:00 p.m. EDT/7:00 p.m. CDT/6:00 p.m. MDT/5:00 p.m. PDT), and will be available to stream following the ceremony. ABC will air a primetime special, "2023 Rock & Roll Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony," featuring performance highlights and standout moments on MONDAY, JAN. 1, 2024 (8:00-11:00 p.m. EST), available the next day on Hulu and Disney+.
