'20/20' IS FRIDAY'S NO. 1 NEWSMAGAZINE, BEATING 'DATELINE' IN ALL KEY DEMOS: TOTAL VIEWERS, ADULTS 18-49 AND ADULTS 25-54

Season to Date, '20/20' Leads 'Dateline' Across the Board and Is Up in Total Viewers

"20/20" ranked as Friday's No. 1 newsmagazine and beat NBC's "Dateline" across the board: Total Viewers (+4% - 2.6 million vs. 2.5 million), Adults 18-49 (+67% - 0.5/4 vs. 0.3/2) and Adults 25-54 (+40% - 0.7/4 vs. 0.5/3).

Season to date, "20/20" is leading NBC's "Dateline" in Total Viewers (+7% - 3.2 million vs. 3.0 million), Adults 18-49 (+25% - 0.5/4 vs. 0.4/3) and Adults 25-54 (+33% - 0.8/4 vs. 0.6/3). In addition, "20/20" is up in Total Viewers (+7% - 3.2 million vs. 3.0 million).

"20/20" reported on the Menendez Brothers' newfound TikTok fame and had a new interview with convicted murderer Lyle Menendez from prison.
