## 'GOOD MORNING AMERICA' IS THE MOST-WATCHED MORNING NEWS PROGRAM

'GMA' Increases Its Lead Over 'Today' by Double Digits Week to Week and Year to Year, Outdelivering by Its Largest Margin in 6 Months

Season to Date, 'GMA' Ranks as the No. 1 Morning Newscast in Total Viewers for the 13th Consecutive Year

"Good Morning America" ranked as the No. 1 morning newscast in Total Viewers (2.665 million) for the 7th week in a row during the week of April 14, 2025, based on Live+Same Day Data from Nielsen Media Research. "GMA" outdelivered NBC's "Today" (2.489 million) by 176,000 to post its largest lead in 6 months – since w/o 10/7/24.

- "GMA" increased its lead over "Today" by double digits both week to week (+35% 176,000 vs. 130,000) and year to year (+56% 176,000 vs. 113,000).
- On Wednesday (4/16/25), "GMA" posted its largest single-day Total Viewer lead over "Today" (+394,000 2.715 million vs. 2.321 million) in 16 months since 12/26/23, based on regular telecasts.

- For the third consecutive week, "GMA" narrowed its gaps with "Today" for the year-ago week in Adults 25-54 (-25% 127,000 vs. 169,000) and Adults 18-49 (-15% 97,000 vs. 114,000).
- "GMA" (2.665 million, 451,000 and 280,000, respectively) beat "CBS Mornings" (2.453 million, 404,000 and 246,000, respectively) in Total Viewers (+212,000), Adults 25-54 (+47,000) and Adults 18-49 (+34,000). "GMA" led "CBS Mornings" in Total Viewers and Adults 25-54 for the last 1,369 weeks overall since w/o 1/18/99.
- Season to date, "GMA" (2.699 million) is ranking as the No. 1 morning newscast in Total Viewers for the 13<sup>th</sup> consecutive year since the 2012-2013 season. "GMA" is leading NBC's "Today" (2.697 million) and "CBS Mornings" (2.029 million).

Emmy® Award-winning "Good Morning America," featuring the anchor team of Robin Roberts, George Stephanopoulos, Michael Strahan and chief meteorologist Ginger Zee, airs live Monday-Friday (7:00-9:00 a.m. EDT) on ABC. Simone Swink is the senior executive producer.
