Emmy® Award-winning producers Jesse Collins and Dionne Harmon, and Emmy®-nominated Jeannae Rouzan-Clay of Jesse Collins Entertainment are set to return as executive producers of the "76th Emmy® Awards." This marks their second consecutive year as executive producers of television's biggest night. The "76th Emmy Awards" will air live coast to coast from the Peacock Theater at L.A. LIVE in Los Angeles on **SUNDAY**, **SEPT. 15** (8:00-11:00 p.m. EDT/5:00-8:00 p.m. PDT), on ABC and stream next day on <u>Hulu</u>.
