RITA ORA JOINS RYAN SEACREST LIVE FROM TIMES SQUARE AS CO-HOST OF 'DICK CLARK'S NEW YEAR'S ROCKIN' EVE WITH RYAN SEACREST 2024'

JEANNIE MAI SET TO CO-HOST FROM LOS ANGELES WHILE DAYANARA TORRES RETURNS AS CO-HOST FROM PUERTO RICO

Ryan Seacrest-led No. 1 New Year's Eve Extravaganza Airs LIVE Sunday, Dec. 31, Beginning at 8/7c on ABC

Today, ABC and Dick Clark Productions announced that "Dick Clark's New Year's Rockin' Eve with Ryan Seacrest 2024," the nation's most-watched New Year's Eve celebration, has new co-hosts to anchor the evening's festivities from coast to coast. Host **Ryan Seacrest** will lead the countdown to midnight alongside global superstar **Rita Ora** live from Times Square. From an electrifying new stage in Los Angeles, Emmy[®] Award-winning television personality **Jeannie Mai** will co-host the Hollywood party in the Pacific Time zone.

Ringing in the new year at midnight in the Atlantic Time zone (11 p.m. EST) from Puerto Rico, "Dick Clark's New Year's Rockin' Eve with Ryan Seacrest 2024" will feature its Spanish-language countdown with multitalented actress, singer and TV presenter **Dayanara Torres** returning as co-host. The New Year's bash will take place on the grounds of the Puerto Rico Convention Center at DISTRITO T-Mobile, Puerto Rico's leading entertainment and nightlife complex.

Far and away, the No. 1 New Year's Eve special for over 30 years, ABC's "Dick Clark's New Year's Rockin' Eve with Ryan Seacrest 2023" attracted 13.8 million Total Viewers and averaged 4.1/29 among Adults 18-49 last year. ABC's annual New Year's Eve special drew in 17.9 million Total Viewers and hit a 5.3 Adult 18-49 rating in the midnight quarter-hour.

"Dick Clark's New Year's Rockin' Eve with Ryan Seacrest 2024" will air Sunday, Dec. 31, live on ABC at 8:00 p.m. EST. The show, which marks its 52nd year, celebrates the year's very best in music with more than 5 ½ hours of dynamic performances, America's favorite personalities and a look at New Year's celebrations around the globe. Rita Ora is an international critically acclaimed singer-songwriter with over 10 billion streams, four No. 1 UK singles and 13 Top 10 UK singles. She was among the first to receive a BRIT Billion award after surpassing the landmark of 1 billion career UK streams.

Deemed "a personal milestone for Ora" by the Associated Press and summarized by Rolling Stone as "a collection of stunning love songs," Ora's new album, "You & I" features the No. 1 U.S. Dance Radio hit "Praising You (featuring Fatboy Slim)," which PAPER declared "a house banger" and "You Only Love Me," lauded by Billboard as "a finely crafted ode to complicated romance" where Ora proves to be "an expert in the type of sleekly designed, electro-tinged pop on display." soon star opposite Jamie Foxx and Robert De Niro in the upcoming film "Tin Soldier" and will join Brandy in the "Descendants" sequel "The Rise of Red" on Disney+.
