SEASON FOUR OF EMMY®-WINNING 'BIG CITY GREENS' TO PREMIERE FRIDAY, SEPT. 23 ON DISNEY CHANNEL

- Season four of Disney Branded Television's Emmy-winning "Big City Greens" is set to debut Friday, Sept. 23 (8:00-8:30 p.m. EDT) on Disney Channel.
- In addition to the premiere date, the key art was also revealed today.
- Created and executive produced by brothers Chris and Shane Houghton, "Big City Greens" follows mischievous and optimistic 10-year-old Cricket Green who moves from the country to the big city with his wildly out of place family—quirky older sister Tilly, hard-working father Bill and sweet-and-sour Gramma Alice.
- In season four, the comedic, wacky adventures continue as the Green family establishes a new normal, with Nancy staying on the country farm while the rest of the Greens return to Big City.
- Produced by Disney Television Animation, episodes of the fourth season of the animated comedy-adventure series will also be available on Disney+ beginning Wednesday, Oct. 25. The first three seasons are currently available on Disney+.
- "Big City Greens" ranks as the No. 1 Disney animated comedy of 2023 to date with kids 6-11.*
- The fourth season includes a landmark 100th episode of the hit series.
