'Bearing Witness: Fighting the Rise of Antisemitism' Streams Wednesday, April 27, on ABC News Live

ABC News Live presents a primetime special on the rise in antisemitism cases across the world, which are at an all-time high according to the Anti-Defamation League. Airing on Yom HaShoah, Holocaust Remembrance Day, the report highlights the importance of understanding the atrocities of the Holocaust so history does not repeat itself.
